Saint Mary's University of Minnesota (SMUMN), U.S.A. and Vignan's Foundation for Science, Technology and Research University (VFSRTU), Andhra Pradesh, India, to promote educational cooperation and in consideration of mutual benefits, have reached the following agreement:

Section 1 Programs – Cooperation between SMUMN and VFSRTU will focus on areas of common interest, and will include, but not limited to, the following:

- 1.1 SMUMN and VFSRTU will explore a program of study for graduate students to study in the United States at Saint Mary's University of Minnesota's Winona campus to earn a Master of Science in Information Technology Management degree from SMUMN, following completion of one year of successful study at VFSRTU. Development of a program will include articulation of VU curriculum to SMUMN curriculum with the expectation of developing a 1 + 1 model.
- 1.2 SMUMN and VFSRTU will explore a program of study for undergraduate students from VU to study at Saint Mary's University of Minnesota's Winona campus for a study abroad experience of one or two semesters during the final year of their study.
- 1.3 SMUMN and VFSRTU will explore possible collaborations to support faculty-led short-term study abroad experiences in India.
- 1.4 SMUMN and VFSRTU will explore short-term collaborations for English as a Second Language preparation and short-term faculty development programming that would combine ESL and learning design and instructional technology.
- 1.5 SMUMN and VFSRTU will explore opportunities for faculty research and exchange.

## Section 2 Considerations

UNIVERSITY

2.1 SMUMN and VFSRTU agree to undertake a process of review to establish possible articulation of courses from VFSRTU programs to majors at SMUMN.

2.2 VFSRTU will provide SMUMN with official course syllabi in English, which include course descriptions, course contact and credits, course content and learning outcomes. 2.3 SMUMN will provide VFSRTU with official course syllabi in English, which include course descriptions, course contact and credits, course content and learning outcomes. 2.4 SMUMN and VFSRTU will provide contact information for the appropriate institutional representatives engaging in discussions based on the initiative being considered and area of responsibility or expertise. Section 3 Term, Revisions and Applicable Laws 3.1 This agreement shall be effective upon execution and shall continue for three years from the date of execution or until terminated by either party upon ninety (90) days written notice, with or without cause. 3.2 Amendments and/or revisions to the Agreement may be made in writing at any time by mutual consent of both parties. Such amendments and/or revisions signed by authorized representatives of both parties shall be prepared in the form of an Addendum to the Agreement. The parties shall work cooperatively to review annually, and to update each year as appropriate, specific items or procedures included in this agreement. All changes made to this agreement will become effective on July 1st 2016 following the date of the addendum, unless specified otherwise. 3.3 Realization of any specific projects initiated within this agreement will be stipulated in separate specific agreements. Each party shall hold all documents, business strategies, tactics, notes, discussions, contracts, and agreements provided by the other in strict confidence. In order for courses to transfer to Saint Mary's ITM program, the grade earned must be a B (or its equivalent) or higher. Students must provide an official Vignan University transcript in English.

This articulation requires that the student successfully complete a minimum of 21 credits in the ITM program at Saint Mary's University of Minnesota to earn the degree.
