





The event was planned with live project demonstrations, paper presentation contests, quizzes, workshops and lectures in collaboration with academic institutions and industries. The fest was planned under the broad main themes viz., Internet of Things (IoT), Embedded Electronics, Robonical, Environment and Biosciences and Shark Tank. Many industries like, Key Sight Technologies, Spoors Technologies, CallHealth, etc. participated in the event by way of exhibitions, technical competitions and lectures.








HIP-HOP DANCE WORKSHOP


