




One of the painting painted at Theme Painting



B.Tech who highlighted the different roles that a woman dons for the welfare of family and society during her lifetime. It was followed by an eloquent presentation on the topic 'Evolving Status of Women in India' by the Gender Champion of the university, Jonah Watts of III BME. Extending his greeting to all the women faculty, staff and students on the occasion, Vice-Chancellor, Dr. M.Y.S. Prasad reminded them to be mindful of the social reality when it came to women's development in India. He spoke of the great disparity that still prevailed in the status of urban vs. rural women and educated vs. uneducated women in India. The condition of women in large parts of rural India is still very lamentable, he said. Dean, E & M, Dr. Madhusudhan Rao said that if we were to read our Indian Mythology, all the important portfolios like Finance, Defence and Education were held by Goddesses Lakshmi, Durga and Saraswati. Registrar, Cmde. Raghunathan spoke about the great strides being made by women and referred to the hisis no scope for gender bias and both men and women faculty and students in the university have to be active and make research contribution. The Vice-Chairman, Mr. Krishnadevarayulu spoke on the need for women to be physically robust by adopting a good diet and a healthy lifestyle. He advised those present that instead of complaining that women are treated unequally, they should take proactive steps to get good educations and skills and build successful careers.

Introducing the guests to the gathering, Prof. N. Usha Rani announced that VFSTR was inaugurating a WIE subsection under the IEE in Chapter of the university. 


REPUBLIC DAY

SANKRANTHI CELEBRATIONS








SPORTS FETE - 2018




Just a Minute competition was organized on 18th Dec 2017 where the participants were given a topic and they need to express their views on that in a time duration of 1 minute.

This event was supervised by Mr. Anirudh Associate Dean Student Affairs.








DANDIYA IS THE DANCE ON GARBA FLOOR & CELEBRATING FESTIVAL WITH FRIENDS & FAMILIES.

Following a few other dance performances by the freshers, the H.O.D, science and humanities addressed the first year students, encouraged and motivated them.


The rest of the performances were followed by prize distribution that has taken place for half an hour for NSS,NCC and for sports events like volley ball, throw ball etc.,

The puja was ended around 12:30 pm.




