Introduction: Business English Certificate Training was conducted for the eligible B.Tech students. After the training the students were assessed by the Cambridge English Language Assessment. Finally, the Cambridge English Assessment issues certificates for qualified students.

Training:

An intensive training was given to the eligible students who were trained on the pattern of the BEC (Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking aspects). The training was conducted from July 1 to July 11, 2015, about 50 hours of training was imparted.

Training Methodology: The students are trained by using

- Practice work sheets to deal with the written part of examination
- Practice work sheets to develop reading comprehensibility of the students
- Audio and video clippings to develop their listening ability
- Interactive sessions along with the presentations to develop students' speaking examinations skills
- Mock question papers to familiarize and to deal with BEC examination

In addition to the training given by the in-house trainers, the university also has a tie-up with outside agencies to come and impart extra training to the students.



Recommendations:

- It is recommended that more training hours are required, especially for speaking and listening skills, to train the students for the exam.
- So far, the students are allowed with two backlogs or no backlogs for the examination. Keeping the previous results and training experiences, the backlogs of a student should not be considered as a criterion to take the examination. Because, the students with backlogs are interested to attend the training and capable to achieve the level of the examination but they were ineligible due to their backlogs. Since the exam is testing language skills of the student so, the students' should be allowed after passing a screening test.
- The training and the examination should be conducted before the semester ends. As many
 of the students, especially hostellers vacate the hostels during the vacations. These results
 a low attendance as well the impact of the training doesn't hold long.
