

V-SAT Results Released today

Vignan Scholastic Aptitude Test (V-Sat'19) results of B.Tech/ B.Pharm courses of Vignan's University were released on Wednesday, 01st May by the Vice – Chancellor Dr.M.Y.S.Prasad.

After releasing the results, Dean-Admissions Dr. V.Ravi Kumar disclosed that **A.Venkata Sai Santhosh** secured 1st Rank under MPC group and **Jacinth Angelina** secured 1st rank under BiPC group in VSAT. He added that rank cards can be downloaded from the website "www.vignan.ac.in". The Counseling for admission into B.Tech/B.Pharm courses based on V-SAT / JEE (Mains) and Intermediate marks will start from 09th May 2019 in the University premises. Counseling for EAMCET rankers will start after the declaration of EAMCET ranks.

He also added that students who were not able to attend V-SAT also can join the Vignan's Deemed to be University through their EAMCET or JEE (Mains) ranks and Intermediate marks. They can also avail scholarships depending on their EAMCET, IIT-JEE ranks or Intermediate marks. In the year 2018-19 38 students got 100% scholarship, 153 students got 50% scholarship and 246 students got 25% scholarship worth more than Rs.4 crores.

In the academic year 2019-2020 75% scholarship will be offered to the top 50 rankers of V SAT, 50% scholarship for 51 to 100 rankers, 25% scholarship for 101 to 200 rankers and 10% scholarship for 201 to 2000 rankers.

Limited seats are available in each branch under scholarship quota. These seats will be filled on the basis of merit, availability of scholarship seats in that branch and on first come first served basis.

Study abroad: Vignan's Deemed to be University has signed MoUs with overseas Universities for students exchange, joint research collaboration and staff exchange. The students are undergoing semester / year long internships in the leading Universities of France, South Korea, Taiwan, Japan, Singapore etc.

Registrar Cmde.Dr.M.S.Raghunadhan said that in Vignan's Deemed to be University

Students, along with their major programme in engineering, are trained towards in preparation for civil services and national level prestigious exams like IAS, IPS, and IES. Students are also



offered coaching for banking and finance sector jobs, jobs in public sector industries and AP state government group examinations.

He added that the innate talent of a student is identified and ideas of the students are shared with the faculty members through young innovators club and encouragement is given to enterprising students.

He also said that IBM centre of excellence reaches out to the campus and offers training on its tools and technologies through this centre. The trained students are provided with certification at the end of these add-on courses that are imparted by IBM.

Business Skill Development Programme: The Ministry of Medium and Small Scale Enterprises (MSME) conducts business and entrepreneurship programmes to elicit and promote the entrepreneurial and managerial skills of students who are seeking to make-out their own careers through start ups. Through this programme many students have been benefitted. In fact, some of them have initiated their Start Ups with guidance of mentors from successful business houses.

Incubation Centers: Many students explore their bright and innovative ideas and convert these ideas into reality at the incubation centers present on the campus. Through these centers some of the best ideas have been marketed and commercial feasibility has been arrived at. One of the incubation centers that was started and currently functioning is "INDO – NACOP" project. Through this students are engaged in exploring ways and means to come up with natural /organic colours.

Andhra Pradesh State Skill Development centre (APSDC): As part of Prime Minister's initiative of "Make in India" a skill development centre worth Rs. 4.0 Crores has been established by the Government of Andhra Pradesh under the National Skill Development Program. In this centre, Vignan's Deemed to be University students and unemployed youth of neighbouring areas are trained in the technologies like Home Appliances, Welding, Machining, Electrical wiring etc. Every year 400 youth are undergoing training at this centre.

Vice-Chancellor Dr. M.Y.S.Prasad on this occasion has brought out that more than 20 % students from AP, Telangana have appeared for this exam as compared to last year. The V SAT results are released within five days of completion of the test. V-SAT in other states like Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal, Odisha and Kerala will be conducted in the second week of May.



The counseling based on VSAT, JEE (Mains) ranks and Inter marks is scheduled from 09th May 2019 onwards in the varsity premises at Vadlamudi.

In this connection, he emphasized that in Vignan's Deemed to be University, the continuous updation of the syllabus on semester basis ensures that the students are always well versed on industry relevant areas. From this academic year 2019-20, R-19 curriculum will be implemented in which every topic of the syllabus is integrated to laboratory and project based learning with emphasis on interdisciplinary, intradepartmental and sociocentric projects makes teaching interesting and attractive. This helps the student to gain a complete understanding rather than simply memorizing and remembering the subject.

In addition to the regular teaching, a 200 hours Campus Recruitment Training (CRT) programme is part of the UG curriculum. The training covers the areas of Aptitude, Reasoning and Analytical Skills and Programming Skills. It is aimed at enhancing the on-campus placement chances, he added.

He emphasized that by imparting subject knowledge as well as skill based applications and through inculcation of a positive attitude among its students, Vignan caters to the special and need based training of its students. This year 1275 students i.e., more than 90% of the students already placed in reputed companies like TCS, IBM, HCL, Virtusa, Osmosis, Syntel, Hyundai Mobis, Westline, Vedic Soft, Just Dail, Axis Bank, Hetero, TCS Tech, Sutherland, Future group, Omics international etc., with handsome packages. The rest have taken up moving higher studies and entrepreneurship.
